

Redpoint Interaction Version 6.6.1 – Release Note

1 About this Document

This document describes Redpoint Interaction (RPI) version 6.6.1. This point release includes a minimal number of functional changes, along with a number of bug fixes.

The document contains the following sections:

- User Stories: documents the user stories included in the release.
- Bugs: documents the bugs resolved in the release.
- Upgrade considerations: issues to be considered when upgrading to RPI v6.6.1.

2 User Stories

Use OAuth Authentication at SFMC SMS

The RPI Salesforce Marketing Cloud (SFMC) SMS provider now supports the use of OAuth authentication.

Facebook API v14 Support

RPI now supports version 14 of the Facebook API. Version 13 remains supported. Support for Version 12 has been deprecated. Any Facebook channels that use a previous version of the API will be updated automatically to use v14, and will require re-authentication before they can be used.

New Configuration Setting - SQLServerUseWildcardCount

A new system configuration setting (SQLServerUseWildcardCount) has been added. If set to True, Azure SQL and SQL Server data warehouse and auxiliary database queries will use the `COUNT (*)` SQL syntax. If set to False, the `COUNT ([primary key])` SQL syntax will be used instead. Note that this will apply also when using `COUNT_BIG` (enabled in turn when setting `SQLServerUseCountBig` is set to True).

Azure SQL DatabaseInsertBatchLimit at all INSERT SELECT Queries

Batching behavior controlled by system configuration setting `DatabaseInsertBatchLimit` is now applied at RPI-generated temporary tables within all `INSERT SELECT` queries

4 Upgrade Notes

Please note the following when upgrading to RPI v6.6.1.

- The following applies if:
 - RPI is using a SQL Server operational database or SQL Server data warehouse
 - The SQL Server(s) in question are not cloud native (e.g. this would not apply if using Azure SQL).

After upgrade, the following must be manually appended to existing text within the SQL Server connection strings listed below:

```
;TrustServerCertificate=True
```

This applies at the following connection strings:

- Interaction API (web.config)
- Node Manager (.exe.config)
- Execution Service (.exe.config)
- Realtime Agent (web.config)
- All client connection strings in Pulse.RPI Clients table (data warehouse, operational, etc.)
